Our second year competing in an all relays gala. Our swimmers had the opportunity to swim the various strokes with different age groups. South East Regionals Championships (4th –6th May 2013)

Finn Bailey is our first qualifier at Regionals Championships for a number of years. He has qualified for 50m and 100m Freestyle and 50m Butterfly. Finn set a new club record U16 Long Course) in the 50m Freestyle in a time of 26.49. He finished the 100m Freestyle in 1.00.16 and 50m Butterfly in 30.50
